

Previous to studying law there he had pursued studies at Carleton College at Northfield, Minnesota, and at Oberlin College, Oberlin, Ohio. On his admission to the Bar in Ohio in 1S95, he entered at once upon the general practice of law in the city of Toledo and so continued until the fall of 1912. In 1898 he was appointed lecturer upon the subject of Medical Jurisprudence in the Toledo Medical College, and continued his services in that connection for about fourteen years. In the summer of 1908 Mr. Wells was instrumental in organizing a law department in connection with St. John s College in Toledo, and for four years was closely identified therewith, both as a teacher and in an administrative capacity.
