

Subsequently, they and others instituted a series of complex forensic tests in the hope of finding the probable causes of the composer s chronically bad health, his deafness, and the final demise that Ferdinand Hiller had witnessed all those years ago. The results, revealed for the first time here, are startling, and are the most compelling explanation yet offered...
