The annual losses due to insect attack on vegetable crops is estimated at 20 per cent., or double that of the average farm crop. The injurious vegetable-feeding forms outnumber in species the insect enemies of any other single class of crops, excepting possibly deciduous fruits, and this nearly endless variety of pests necessitates information in regard to each. Many are intermittent in attack, hence the grower should be forewarned in order to guard against injury or to check it before irreparable damage has been accomplished. The progressive vegetable grower should be as amply equipped with knowledge as the fruit grower, and if he would be entirely successful in avoiding losses from insect ravages he should be provided with a complete outfit for spraying operations and should...
