Would require that lights on the front end of a motor vehicle be placed, one on each side, and that they not exceed twenty-four candle power. Regulates the placement of such lights so as to avoid glare on dazzle. Requires the person operating a motor vehicle or bicycle to dim limits when not less than 400 (now 260) feet of any approaching vehicle. Provides for the testing and approval of antiglare devices and prescribes the specifications and conditions of such tests.
